This seven day / six night excursion will introduce you to several colleges and universities where you will have the chance to experience first-hand what college life is all about, become actively involved in obtaining accurate and reliable information, and have an exciting and educational time with your classmates and friends. You will visit: George Washington University or Georgetown University; Johns Hopkins University or Goucher College; University of Pennsylvania; Swarthmore College or Drexel University; Columbia University or Fordham University; New York University; Yale University; Brown University; Harvard University or Emerson College; Boston University or Tufts University or Wellesley College (YOU CHOOSE SCHOOL TO VISIT WHEN GIVEN OPTION). THE ESTIMATED COST PER STUDENT IS \$2100.
