## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

**HORATIO ALGER CALIFORNIA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** will award \$4000 to 37 high school seniors. Eligibility: enrolled full time as a high school senior, plan to pursue a bachelor degree, critical financial need (\$50K or less adjusted gross income per family preferred), community activities, academic achievement (minimum GPA 2.0), resident of California and citizen of US. Requirements: 2 essays and several forms that must be completed and submitted by October 30, 2011 postmarked. Visit VICCI room 116 for more information.

**HORATIO ALGER NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** will award 104 scholarships in the amount of \$20,000. The National Scholarship Program is awarded to eligible students in all fifty states. Eligibility: enrolled full time as a high school senior, pursue a bachelor's degree, critical financial need (\$50,000 or less adjusted gross income per family), community activities, demonstrated integrity, minimum GPA 2.0, US citizen.
